



DFWCC Technical Advisory Committee Member Frequently Asked Questions:

1. How will Committee members be selected?
 - NCTCOG (North Central Texas Council of Governments) staff will select committee members from eligible nominations received to ensure that (1) at least 51 percent of members are from the public sector, and (2) a broad variety of perspectives are represented, including geographically diverse perspectives
2. Can I nominate myself?
 - Yes!
3. How do I submit a nomination?
 - Nominations should be submitted by email to cleancities@nctcog.org by July 17, 2026
4. What needs to be included in the nomination?
 - The nomination should include a brief description of expertise in Committee topics and reason for interest in the Committee; and
 - A resume of relevant experience
5. What are the expectations of a Committee member?
 - Attend four Committee meetings per year
 - Attend/participate in select DOE trainings/webinars about the Coalition network and national objectives (approximately two per year)
 - Advise and recommend approval of strategic plans
 - Provide input on and assist with event/webinar/training planning, such as by inviting speakers/key attendees
 - Assist with publicizing events
 - Provide recommendations on and assist with community engagement efforts for relevant initiatives
6. How long is a membership appointment?
 - The minimum term length for membership is two years
7. What are some examples of perspectives or areas of expertise the Committee is looking for?
 - Fleet managers
 - Sustainability planners
 - Energy managers
 - Code/permitting officials
 - Alternative fuel vehicle manufacturers
 - Universities
 - Local Governments
 - Alternative fuel providers, including electric, hydrogen, natural gas, propane, biodiesel, and ethanol fuels
 - o Renewable versions of these fuels are especially of interest
 - Solar
 - Special districts
 - Advocacy/Interest Groups
 - Infrastructure Developers
 - Microgrids
